

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I have to submit separate RFP's for different counties within the same catchment area?

No. Only one RFP is required per BPA within the same catchment area. As noted in Section L, Preparation of Background Statement, you must "state expressly each location at which offeror and any proposed subcontractors intend to provide services..."

2. Do I need to submit separate RFP's for Substance Abuse and Mental Health or can I just put it under one blanket form and submit?

Yes, you DO need to submit separate RFP's for different services (i.e. substance abuse and mental health) within the same catchment area as these services are under separate BPA's.

You need to submit completely separate RFP's for each BPA you are bidding on. That means the entire packet of responses for substance abuse, mental health and SOT. For all proposals, an original and ONE (1) copy.

3. What sections of the RFP do I need to return?

The parts you need to make sure you return to us are Sections A, B, K and L (your Narrative Statement, Qualifications and References). The narrative statement should be a detailed description of how you will provide the services according to the requirements of the RFP. Page L-3 gives more description of what is required for this specific statement.

4. Is it alright to bid on Manualized Cognitive Behavioral Group (2022) if our agency has not yet gone through the training for MRT?

Yes. You would just need to specify a projected date for completion of this training.
