ORDER

In accordance with the Opinion of this date;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants' December 7, 2006 Injunction plans (Dkt. No. 2347 & attachments) and transfer plans (Dkt. Nos. 2357 & 2397) are **REJECTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall submit revised plans addressing all of the Court's concerns as to the insufficiencies of the plans within 30 days, and subject to penalties for contempt pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 401.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearing on such plans is reserved pending briefing and the hearing scheduled for May 23, 2007 is **ADJOURNED WITHOUT DATE**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Plaintiffs object to the revised plan language, they should file written objections within seven days of the filing of said plans.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Plaintiffs object to the revised plans, then Defendants shall file a written response within seven days of the filing of the objections, and the Independent Medical Monitor shall file a further report with this Court not later than seven days after the filing of Defendants' response.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the April 25, 2007 report of Independent Medical Monitor Robert Cohen, M.D. regarding D.U. shall be filed under **SEAL** to protect the privacy of D.U.'s medical information and to provide a record of Defendants' treatment of D.U.
