
At a Judges' meeting conducted on February 9, 2001, the District Judges of this Court unanimously decided that the amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, effective December 1, 2000, render this court's Differentiated Case Management Plan unnecessary. The Judges of this Court further determined that repeal of the Court's Differentiated Case Management Plan would foster nationwide uniformity of practice and procedure among the district courts of this country. Accordingly:

IT IS ORDERED that the Differentiated Case Management Plan adopted pursuant to the Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990, as reflected in previous orders of this Court dated December 18, 1991, September 1, 1992, November 17, 1993, December 17, 1993, as well as Administrative Order nos. 94-016 and 96-053, be and they hereby are REPEALED and set aside.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall post a copy of this order in each divisional office and shall provide the order to the Federal Bar Association and other interested parties.
