ORDER OF ASSIGNMENT OF A  
THREE JUDGE PANEL TO CONSIDER  
PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

Attorney MARK S. DEMOREST has filed a petition for reinstatement to practice law in the courts of the Western District of Michigan, and the undersigned, having reviewed the petition and supporting materials, finds that the appointment of a Three Judge Panel is appropriate. Accordingly, the following three Judges are hereby appointed

HONORABLE PAUL L. MALONEY, CHAIR

HONORABLE PHILLIP J. GREEN

HONORABLE JAMES W. BOYD

to review this attorney's petition and determine his suitability for reinstatement to the practicing bar of the Western District of Michigan. Pursuant to Rule, the decision of a majority of the panel will be final and binding. A copy of this Order shall be served upon Attorney Demorest by the Attorney Admissions Clerk.

The Court notes that Mr. Demorest has been the subject of litigation sanctions, including a contempt of court finding, by Chief Bankruptcy Judge Dales. Judge Neff affirmed the imposition of sanctions, and the Court of Appeals affirmed Judge Neff's decision. The litigation is summarized in *In re Modern Plastics Corporation*, 890 F.3d 244 (6th Cir. 2018). A petition for certiorari has been filed and remains pending at this time. The three-judge panel does not include any judicial officer involved in the *Modern Plastics* litigation.
