IN RE: APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS FEES BY DAVID TAN

Administrative Order No. 22-MS-017

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by David Tan for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that David Tan, an associate professor at the University of Washington, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Tan has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.

Accordingly, Tan shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching cases regarding local government litigation against opioid firms. Specifically, he is investigating why some local governments and not others decided to bring litigation against opioid manufacturers, distributors, and retailers.

Tan shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- This fee exemption applies only to David Tan (PACER Account #4497127), and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- 2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;

- 3. By accepting this exemption, Tan agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- 4. Tan is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- 5. This exemption is valid through December 31, 2027.

This Order may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
