IN RE: APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS FEES BY JOHN BENSON

Administrative Order No. 24-MS-014

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by John Benson for

exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the

Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that John Benson, a graduate student associated with the University of

St. Andrews, School of International Relations in the U.K., falls within the class of users listed in

the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Benson has demonstrated

that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public

access to information.

Accordingly, Benson shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to

the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course

of researching cases associated with right-wing terrorism in the United States from January 1,

2020 to December 31, 2023.

Benson shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other

uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to John Benson (PACER Account #7860487), and

is valid only for the purposes stated above;

2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are

available through the PACER system;

- 3. By accepting this exemption, Benson agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- 4. Benson is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- 5. This exemption is valid from February 21, 2024, through April 15, 2024.

This Order may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
