ORDER DENYING ATTORNEY'S PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

Attorney Donnelly W. Hadden (P14507) filed his Petition for Reinstatement (the "Petition") to practice before the United States District Court for the Western District of Michigan on September 2, 2016. Upon review of the Petition, Chief Judge Robert J. Jonker referred Attorney Hadden's application to a three-judge panel comprised of United States District Judge Paul L. Maloney, Chair; United States Magistrate Judge Ray S. Kent; and United States Bankruptcy Judge John T. Gregg ("the Panel"). See Admin. Order No. 16-AD-090.

The Panel decided to hold the Petition in abeyance pending the conclusion of an appeal of a State Bar of Michigan disciplinary proceeding involving Attorney Hadden. The court recently received notice that Attorney Hadden has been disbarred from the practice of law by the State Bar of Michigan. Therefore, Attorney Hadden's ability to practice law before this court is revoked pursuant to Local General Rule 2.3(b)(ii).

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney Donnelly W. Hadden shall remain prohibited from practicing before this court unless and until an order of reinstatement has been issued pursuant to the procedures set forth in Local General Rule 2.3(b)(iii).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order upon Attorney Donnelly W. Hadden by first class United States mail at his address of record.
