This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Alejandro

Arredondo for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee

schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Alejandro Arredondo, a student research assistant at the

University of Houston Law Center, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule

as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Arredondo has demonstrated that an

exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public

access to information.

Accordingly, Arredondo shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via

PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is

incurred in the course of researching criminal case records based on DOJ press releases

and looking at those records to identify different theories of prosecution over the span of

10 years. Specifically, Arredondo will search for federal cases that are charged under the

honest services fraud or wire fraud statute involving government officials for no more than

60-80 cases total. Arredondo shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in

connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, the following

limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Arredondo (PACER Account # 6548973), and is valid only for the purposes stated above;

2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that

are available through the PACER system;

3. By accepting this exemption, Arredondo agrees not to sell for profit any data

obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;

4. Arredondo is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of

receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based

databases;

5. This exemption is valid until February 16, 2021.

This Order may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of

this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
