IN THE MATTER OF IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW PROCEDURES FOR THE STORAGE AND MANAGEMENT OF RESTRICTED/SEALED DOCUMENTS

Amended Administrative Order No. 25-MS-089

WHEREAS a recent escalation in cyberattacks on the CM/ECF systems of federal courts requires the implementation of new procedures for the storage and management of restricted access and sealed documents;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective as of the date of this order and until such time as the court orders otherwise:

- Electronic Access to Restricted Access and Sealed Documents. Restricted access and sealed documents will continue to be filed in CM/ECF under existing procedures but will no longer be accessible or viewable by electronic means.
- 2. Service of Restricted Access and Sealed Documents Filed in CM/ECF. Parties will continue to serve sealed documents conventionally by other appropriate means as provided Procedure by the Federal Rules of and the Court's Local Rules (https://www.miwd.uscourts.gov/local-rules-practice-and-procedure). Restricted access documents must be served in the same manner as sealed documents. The Court will serve restricted access and sealed orders, notices, and other Court-generated documents by secure electronic means to attorneys of record and self-represented parties granted CM/ECF filing privileges and via U.S. Mail to non-CM/ECF filers.

4. This Order supersedes any and all inconsistent Court orders, local rules, or other guidance regarding the filing of restricted access and sealed documents.
