ORDER

Attorney Elliott J. Williams applied for admission to practice law in this Court, pursuant to LGenR 2.1(b). At the time, although Mr. Williams was active and in good standing in the State Bar of Oregon, his application stated that there was a pending grievance based on a sanctions order. Mr. Williams further stated the grievance had been tolled pending appeal, and no disciplinary complaint had been filed. Under the Court's procedures regarding the attorney admission process, Mr. Williams was conditionally admitted to practice law before this Court, with further review of his admission to occur after the appeal was concluded. Administrative Order 24-AD-091. Mr. Williams has now advised that the sanctions order the grievance was based on was vacated, the appeal was dismissed, no disciplinary complaint has been filed, and he has received a formal closure letter from the Office of Enrollment and Discipline of the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

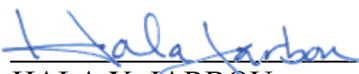
Accordingly,
