WHEREAS, the undersigned has concluded that Case No. 1:25-cv-1800 should be reassigned;


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court shall **REASSIGN** Case No. 1:25-cv-1800 to Judge Beckering.
